GOOD NEWS FROM THE ROTARY FOUNDATION

“Dear Rotarians:

Congratulations! Your global grant application (GG#1759558: Handog Palikuran ng Rotary (Gift of Toilets by Rotary), submitted by RC Intramuros-Manila and RC Batemans Bay, has been approved by The Rotary Foundation. The award is in the amount of \$57,805.”

Our club members should be proud of this achievement and the support of TRF for a project to construct 52 toilets for people who currently have none. The health, hygiene and wellbeing of these village people will be significantly improved with long term sustainability. The project exemplifies TRF's moto of 'doing good' in the world.

The Board has approved a project called Sisters Helpem Sisters – providing re-useable feminine hygiene kits for post maternity women in some of the Pacific Islands. The opportunity for this project arose following the visit by the midwives who were part of the VVT team who visited in November. Many women who give birth in the Pacific Islands do not have access to sanitary products once they return to their island home. A group of ladies led by Vere Gray is making re-useable kits for these women. If you are able to help with the following donations, they would be gratefully received – and save us from buying them. 100% cotton fabric (to make bags which include the kits), flannelette (eg new or old sheets), lengths of ribbon (approx 1 or 2 cm wide and 75cm long), clip lock bags (sandwich size and large size), face washers, small soaps (like you get in motel rooms), Undies (size 20 upwards). Many thanks, Vere.

Billionaire philanthropists Bill and Melinda Gates will pay off \$76 million of Nigeria's debt. It is part of a promise the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation made to the African country in an effort to end polio. The payments, which will be made over the course of 20 years, are due to begin this year. Nigeria had no new cases of polio last year.
