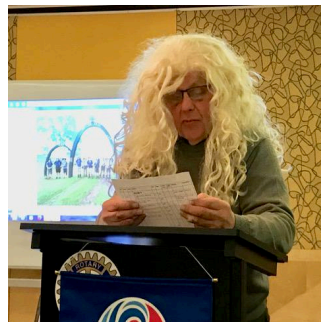

- **Papua New Guinea, Kenya, SYRIA, SOMALIA, Nigeria & DRC** - A new Vaccine Derived Type 2 Polio case was reported in Papua New Guinea this week. No new Vaccine Derived Polio cases were reported in Nigeria this week. None were reported in Kenya. In Somalia, 3 Vaccine derived Polio Virus cases (Type 2 & Type 3) were confirmed. No new cases of vaccine-derived Poliovirus type 2 were reported this week in Syria (last case 9/20/17) leaving the total number of Syrian cases at 74 for 2017 and 0 for 2018. Three new cases were reported in DRC bringing their total to 7 (22 in 2017).
