The feedback was that everyone enjoyed the night immensely. Many Rotarians helped towards the night but David Ashford steered the ship. It was a great effort David and we thank you very much.

Mark Brantingham, the CEO of Yumaro, is a local boy growing up in Tuross and attending Moruya High School. Yumaro (anagram of Moruya) used to only provide Supported Employment but since the roll out of the National Disability Insurance Scheme has expanded greatly. New supported accommodation in Moruya will be opening in October. After initially obtaining an \$800,000 grant, the cost of the innovative project has now come in at \$3.1million! Mark spoke about the NDIS being the biggest social reform since Medicare, costing \$22billion and providing 27,000 new jobs. It empowers the person with a disability by giving them a choice of services and recreational activities available to them by registered service providers.
