Our speaker this week was Rohan Gleeson CEO of Southern Computer Co and Rotarian from Moruya Branch. Rohan gave us an enlightening, if somewhat technical, overview of how the National Broadband Network (NBN) operates, revealing how it relies almost wholly on light beams transmitted over glass fibre networks both domestically and globally. This he demonstrated with a red laser beam shining through a fibre optic strand of glass. He made a point that many of the modems supplied by Internet Service Providers free of charge when moving over to the NBN are of inferior quality and replacing them with a higher quality modem from a reputable electronics dealer would cure many problems associated with new NBN installations. Although quoting many statistics, the general message was that the NBN is worth upgrading to and the closer the fibre can be made available to your premises, the better.
