The planned Community Carers Accommodation at the new SE Regional Hospital in Bega was the subject of Charlie Blomfield's presentation. (The contractor has handed over the keys of the new hospital to SE Health with the official opening planned for the end of the first week of March 2016.) A Steering Committee has been planning the new accommodation facility, which is a

community initiative. Rotarians are currently President and Vice President. Once built the facility will be administered by SE Health for day to day operation and maintenance. The accommodation will be constructed in three stages. A Funding Grant has been applied for to help build the first stage, and many community groups and organisations have also contributed funding. We recently donated \$1000.

WORLDS GREATEST MEAL UPDATE

As at 6 November there have been 1735 events registered in 70 countries (including ours). More than 96,549 participants world wide. USD \$1,453,839 has been raised (a total of USD \$4,361,717 with matching funds from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. This translates to enough funds to buy more than 7,269 polio vaccinations.

Immunisation Days are held in Pakistan and Afghanistan as well as in India and Nigeria to ensure Polio doesn't return to these two countries.
