### PLEASE COLLECT STAMPS

They are being sold to raise funds to help eliminate Trachoma, a curable eye disease most common amongst aboriginal communities in northern Australia.

#### Helpful information

Stamps are sold by weight (per kg) e.g. \$1 stamps and 65c Christmas stamps both attract \$15/kg. For stamps to be saleable, you need to cut a margin of 2mm around each stamp. If the perforations are cut, the stamp is unsaleable. If the stamps are covered in cello tape or crossed with pen, also unsaleable. They need to be in a single piece of paper (not the double corner of the envelope). Stamps without paper backing have very little value, but can be sold. Stamps can be any value, and can be foreign.

Please give your stamp collections to Vere, who will pass them on when the collection builds.
