The Annual Grants Presentation Dinner took place last Thursday to give Grants to 13 deserving young people. We had a crowd of 113 people, which included the DG and the DG Elect. Representation from our Club was just over 40% of membership, very poor indeed. This is the most important Community event on our annual calendar and we need to have much better representation to spread the word about Rotary in the Bay. By contrast, our partners, the Soldiers Club, managed to field 19 Board Members and Managers. They are very proud of their association with BBYF. Even RC Moruya sent up to 6 members.
