INTERNATIONAL TOAST from Peter W:

In 1983 the Royal College of Surgeons established Interplast in conjunction with Rotary, imported from the USA where it was started in 1969. Plastic and reconstructive surgery not only repairs bodies but rebuilds lives. Medical staff travel throughout the Asia Pacific area performing miracles of healing but also teaching indigenous medical people. In 2014 there



were 51 procedures in 27 locations in 16 countries. In 2014 donations, grants and gifts totalled \$2.19M. District Chair Janice Paull.
