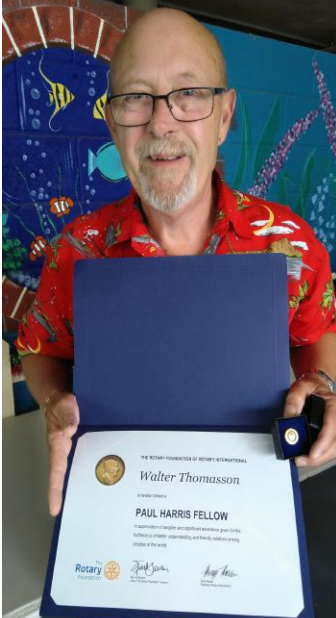
Breakfast Club recommences after Summer Break on 5th February 2019
