### FROM THE BOARD MEETING ON 8 MARCH

1. So far we have four nominations for Pride of Workmanship Awards.
2. The selection Committee for the School Grants this year, for which there are currently three applications, will be Alan Russell, Neil Simpson, Heidi Pohlsen and Maureen Manning.
3. It was resolved that we will host an exchange student for the 2016/17 Rotary year and the student being requested comes from France. We may or may not get our first choice.
4. Council has approved our licence to conduct the market for five years. The Market Committee is working on conditions.
5. Our General Account (our running account) suffers when members do not pay subs on time. In future subs notices will be issued on 1 May and 1 November each year, due and payable one month later. This will mean that we will be able to cover costs to District, RDU and Rotary International due to be paid on 1 July and 1 January. The smooth conduct of the General Account is under discussion.
6. President will attend the District Foundation Grants Seminar on 20 March in Canberra. Attendance is a requirement if we are to apply for a District Grant.
7. The purchase of 3 boxes (30 swags) was ratified by the Board. These will be distributed to the needy in Batemans Bay by the Salvation Army.
8. The Board resolved not to support any Interactors to attend the Rotary Convention in Seoul South Korea.
9. We will send \$1000 to RAWCS to provide humanitarian aid as required in devastated Fiji.
10. It was resolved to pay \$100 Voluntary Financial Assistance to the High School which looks after our exchange students extremely well.
