We heard from Moruya Obstetrician, Dr Michael Holland on Thursday evening. Michael led the charge for the new Eurobodalla Hospital. \$150,000,000 has been committed by the NSW Government to the construction of the new hospital by 2023. We could feel his frustration

as an immediate improvement in services is needed now in the Eurobodalla which, by 2027, is expected to have a population of 40,000. Funding, planning and building is a complicated process but the move towards becoming a Level 4 Service needs to start now allowing staff and the community to transition to a higher level of care in preparation for the new hospital opening. At present Headspace, drug and rehabilitation and radiotherapy services have committed. The site has not as yet been agreed to but can be narrowed down as it will require at least 20 hectares of level land. Michael compared Rotary's Four Way Test to the ethics required to build the new hospital.

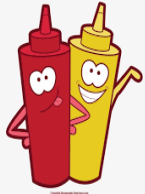
