

The Board has approved a project called Sisters Helpem Sisters – providing re-useable feminine hygiene kits for post maternity women in some of the Pacific Islands. The opportunity for this project arose following the visit by the midwives who were part of the VVT team who visited in November. Many women who give birth in the Pacific Islands do not have access to sanitary products once they return to their island home. A group of ladies led by Vere Gray is making re-useable kits for these women. If you are able to help with the following donations, they would be gratefully received - and save us from buying them. 100% cotton fabric (to make bags which include the kits), flannelette (eg new or old sheets), lengths of ribbon (approx 1 or 2 cm wide and 75cm long), clip lock bags (sandwich size and large size), face washers, small soaps (like you get in motel rooms), Undies (size 20 upwards).
