The Ride (the train) to End Polio Event was one of the more unique fundraisers. It was conceived by Dave Anderson who wondered if it was possible to travel to all 187 railway stations on the Sydney Metro rail network in a single day. Rotarians from the two Districts in the greater Sydney area were asked to join the ride for a stop or two along the route and to spread the Public Image of Rotary and PolioPlus by wearing their **END POLIO NOW shirts. They were also asked to deliver personal, club, and corporate donations for the Polio Eradication effort along the way. Rotarians from all over Sydney joined the riders and donated over \$240,000 - which Dave hopes will grow to over \$333,333 by the final tally - providing over \$1 Mil to the Global Polio Eradication effort with the Gates Foundation match!**
