Cate Mc Math is CEO and she spoke to us on Thursday evening about how the Service had grown since it began four years ago in Batemans Bay. It is certainly fulfilling a need in our area. At present it is running from buildings in the Industrial Estate but this year building has commenced on a new Therapy Centre on Melaleuca Reserve near the High School. After an initial grant from the State Government of \$1.5million, they have found it difficult to fund services for clients especially with the new NDIS rolling out and some clients not being covered by the NDIS at present. Volunteers are welcome to help in fundraising, administration and other areas. A Charity Golf Day is being held at Moruya Golf Club on 27thOctober. A Flyer has been emailed out to Rotarians.
