What can you do to help?

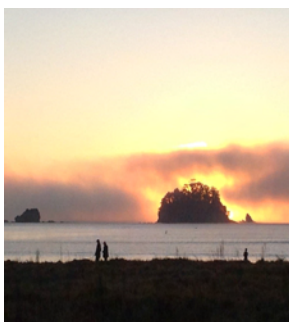
