Building underway

South East Regional Hospital

BUILDING of the South East Regional Hospital's carers accommodation is well under way.

According to Community Carers Accommodation South East president Lynne Koerbin, the first stage of the project is due to be completed in October, and is planned to be operational by Christmas.

"We really are so lucky to live where we live - our community is so generous, and again and again I have been left humbled by the generosity of individuals, community groups and businesses in the way they support the carers accommodation project," Ms Koerbin said.

The organisation is now mapping out the soft furnishings and furniture needed for the first stage's six rooms and shared lounge.

"Each room will be set up in a similar way to a motel room, so we will be needing beds, linen, small tables and chairs, appliances, cutlery and crockery before we can

open the facility to guests," Ms Koerbin said.

"And, we have recently set up a small working group to research products and make

recommendations to our committee ready for purchasing."

Bega company Leser Build was awarded the contract for the Stage 1 build.

"I am glad to be working with such a positive committee, and being part of the reality of something that is so badly needed for our community," David Leser said.

Community groups from across the Bega Valley have supported the concept and construction of the accommodation, since the organ-

isation was allocated land by the hospital for carers and 'potent relatives' to stay overnight. The organisation was formed from members of local service groups, including the Rotary Clubs of Pambula, Bega and Merimbula, Pambula-Merimbula Lions Club, Eden Lionesses and the CWA.
