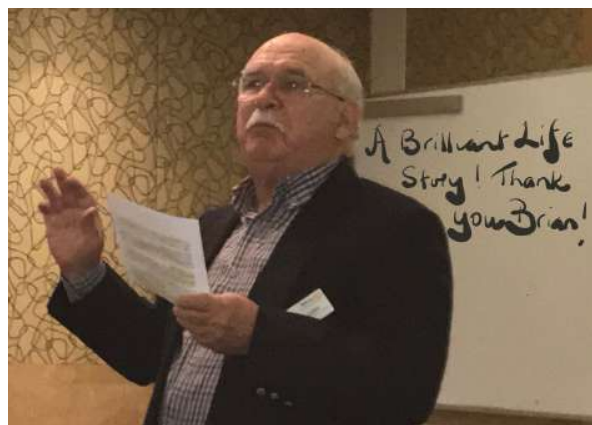
**24 AUGUST, 2017**
