

There is a new Community Building with commercial kitchen, dining area and two comfortable lounges. The additional six motel style units are well equipped and have delightful views. All this is just a short step from the hospital. The cost will be \$45 per night and they are available to families of patients in hospital or maybe day surgery patients who have a distance to travel to the hospital. The opening was concluded with Aboriginal dances and a smoking ceremony to kill bad spirits on the site.
