Our International Director, Vere Gray gave an excellent presentation at the meeting on Thursday. One of the Rotary Foundation's area of focus is disease prevention and treatment. The Polio Plus Program is Rotary's finest achievement and 23 October is World Polio Day to highlight the fight against this crippling disease. The final three endemic countries are Pakistan, Afghanistan and Nigeria. There have been eleven cases reported this year – we are so close and must not lose focus. Rotary raises funds and the World Health Organisation organises the programs. Our club has donated \$2000 annually for many years. For a small donation members had their pinkie painted, which is how the children are identified after vaccination. On Thursday, we raised an extra \$33 which equates to \$100 after the 2:1 match from the



Gates Foundation. In 2017 the Gates Foundation announced an increased combined pledge of up to \$450million per year over three years. Together we can – and we will do it!

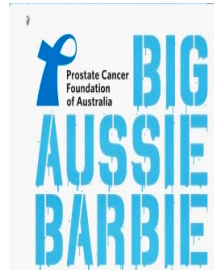
