

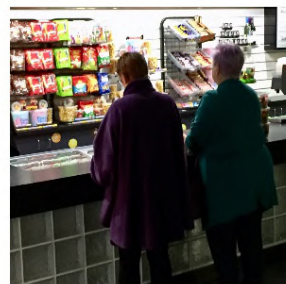

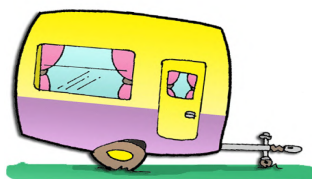
MHERV is a consulting room caravan with a male
