### **END POLIO UPDATE**

*One polio case reported this week- in Afghanistan*



Pakistan has become the second polio-endemic country to introduce the inactivated polio vaccine into the country's routine immunization schedule, a move which will benefit more than four million children per year across the country. New evidence has clearly demonstrated that adding one dose of IPV to OPV offers to children as they fight to end transmission of the virus.
