INTERNATIONAL TOAST from Peter W:

SHELTERBOX - was started at RC Helston-Lizard (UK) in 2000. In 2001 they distributed 143 boxes; in 2002-2004, 2600 boxes to 16 major disasters. In 2005, 22,000 boxes as a result of the Indian Ocean Tsunami, Hurricane Katrina, USA, Kashmir, Pakistan. In 2013 after Typhoon Haiyan in the Philippines Shelterbox had a team of over 100 people there. Boxes supplied to Vanuatu and Nepal in 2015. A Shelterbox costs \$AUD1000.
