2016 BOWELCARE PROGRAM

Bowelcare kits will be available at all local pharmacies from 1 April till 31 May. Kits cost \$15. The cost includes testing and advice of results to you and your nominated doctor within 30 days of receipt of the kit by pathology. Kits are returned in the pre-paid envelope. There are no dietary or medical restrictions to undertake testing – one sample from two different days.

The Program is being administered for our club by Bruce Gruber and Peter Kable.

WHAT'S THE CENTURIAN PROGRAM?

To become a Centurian you need to personally give \$100 to the Rotary Foundation. It is hoped participants will make this an annual contribution. This can be done by giving \$100 outright or by giving a few dollars at each Rotary meeting. Treasurer Bruce keeps a spreadsheet of contributions and can advise you at any time the amount of your contributions. Once \$100 is received, he sends this to the Rotary Foundation in your name. END POLIO UPDATE -



In acknowledgement of his government's efforts to keep Nigeria polio free, Rotary presented President Buhari with its Polio Eradication Champion Award. Shortly after taking office in July 2015 President Buhari demonstrated his personal commitment to ending polio by publically

immunising his young granddaughter. In September he launched polio immunisation campaigns in his home town and recently he convened a Presidential Task Force on Polio eradication through which 36 Nigerian State Governors reaffirmed their commitment to keeping Nigeria polio-free.
