The graffic is of Rotary's announcement of \$35 million in grants to support the global effort to end Polio. In 2015, the world saw historic progress against the paralyzing disease, with just two countries – Afghanistan and Pakistan – reporting a single strain of the wild virus. If the current momentum is strengthened, this year may mark the last case of wild poliovirus. Could 2016 be the year of
