### The Final Two Endemic Countries:



**Pakistan** - No new Polio cases reported this week. Thirteen Polio cases reported in 2016 with 54 cases recorded in 2015. The most recent case, with the onset of paralysis on 06/18/16 was from the South Waziristan agency of FATA. **One new Polio-positive environmental sample was collected this past week.** In Pakistan, both the oral polio vaccine and the inactivated poliovirus vaccine are being used hand in hand to boost immunity; and committed healthcare workers are going to great lengths to build trust and to ensure every child is vaccinated.

**Afghanistan** - No Polio cases reported this week. Six Polio cases reported in 2016 with 20 cases recorded in 2015. The most recent case, with an onset of paralysis on 05/29/16 from the Shigal Wa Sheltan district of Kunar. **No new Polio-positive environmental samples were collected in Afghanistan in 2016.** National Immunization Days are planned for August 22 - 25 & October 3-7.

**Nigeria** - Two Polio cases reported this week with the onset of paralysis on 7/6/16 and

7/13/16 in the Borno state in northeast Nigeria. 2016 with 0 cases recorded in 2015.
