INTERNATIONAL TOAST

Rotary Oceania Medical Aid for Children (ROMAC)

is a humanitarian program of the 27 Rotary Districts of Australia and New Zealand and is the only Rotary sponsored childrens medical program.

Children requiring life changing surgery are brought to Australia, some to New Zealand, where they are operated on by top surgeons on a pro bono basis.

350 children have been operated on since ROMAC's inception in 1988. Donations pay for airfares, cost of living for patient and parent and other expenses. The children often spend some months here if multiple operations are performed. Donations in 2013 exceeded \$750k.

ROMAC is run by a team of Rotarians led in this District by Chair Sandra Mahlberg, winner of Canberra's Citizen of the Year Award, and winner of many Rotary recognitions. Last Rotary year our club donated \$1000 to ROMAC.
