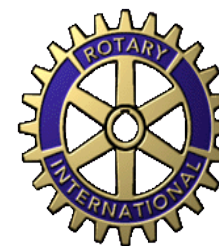

## Last Meeting 2706 Laurelle Pacey Montague Island

What an interesting talk we had from Laurelle a writer, historian and Rotarian from Narooma.

Laurelle has written eight books covering four titles. She has updated a number of her history books as new historical material comes to be known.

Her address covered her third edition of her book on Montague Island and that she had rewritten four aspects of the book with new facts and new pictures. Her knowledge and love for the area and the island in particular was most evident.

There have been many identities in the area with Judith Cassell, Mrs Verion Nathan, whalers, Lighthouse keepers, Aboriginal people and news people highlighted in the various tales noted.

The history of the island its ownership by State and the Commonwealth, the involvement of the National Trust and the National Parks and Wildlife Service were highlighted. It was good to hear of birds and vegetation returning and the upgrade of the buildings through the conservation works of the various organisations.

It was recommended as a place to visit and to stay overnight. We hope someone is able to enjoy this opportunity at some stage- day tripper or overnight 'camper'.

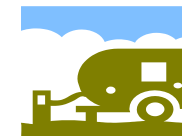
