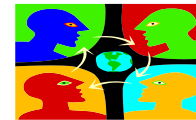

with the Philippines**

The Board asked Peter to update the Club on the considerable achievements and contributions which have been made by the Club through our twinning with the Intramuros Club (D3810) in the Philippines and which have been rewarded twice with awards honouring our work.

Developed and encouraged by Peter we have had a considerable impact upon the lives of children and their family groups since 2003, and we continue to do so.



We have provided water to 15 villages, 23 schools and 1 hospital. In making sure each project is sustainable, each community must be able to maintain the equipment for it to be worthwhile. To date there have been no reports of failures!

We have also aided projects to assist with educational equipment such as desks and after the typhoon there was teaching equipment sent for each child so their schooling could continue.
