What a wonderful night we had. There was a great deal of chatter and a sense of fun as we assembled at Sam's Restaurant overlooking the Clyde River.



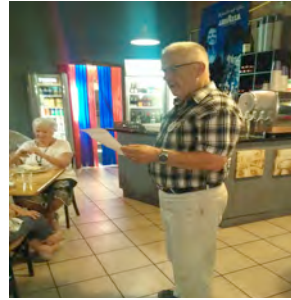
