provides funding for a variety of smaller
local community activities and initiatives.
However, the *Community Grants Scheme*has been introduced to identify significant
major projects in the Batemans Bay local
area for possible financial support.

Under this scheme organisations or groups are able to apply for significant funding to develop community infrastructure, implement community service programs or purchase major items of equipment that are of direct benefit to the local Batemans Bay community.

As a guide, suitable projects under this scheme would seek funding from \$2000 to \$25000 and would involve funding from a variety of other sources in addition to Rotary Club funding.
