Summary of Board Meeting 16th May 2024

- The Board resolved to not participate in this year's Eurobodalla Health and Community Expo.
- The Board resolved to support a motion to the Council on Resolutions from the Rotary Club of Jerrabomberra to initiate a review of the value and costs of publishing Rotary magazines.
- The Board resolved to not support a motion from Canberra Burley Griffin relating to the elimination of nuclear weapons.
- The Board has requested the Nelligen Park Board to consider allocating part of the annual grant as an administration fee payable to the General Account.
- The Board resolved to amend the Educational Initiative Grant to St Peters Anglican College to not fund the Textiles project previously approved and transfer the funds (\$1,000.00) to purchase underwater cameras for a separate project and increase the grant to \$ 1854.00.
- Nicole McDonald as Treasurer-elect briefed the Board on the introduction of Xero software to replace the existing Xcel spreadsheet system for each of the three bank accounts.
- The Board resolved to appoint David Friedlieb, Nicole McDonald and Pam Thorpe to the 2024-2025 Paul Harris Committee.
- The Board noted the Club Assembly meeting on 30th May will discuss ways to subsidise Rotary fees.
- The Board resolved to continue the funding of baby books to all new mothers giving birth in Moruya Hospital in conjunction with the Moruya and Narooma Rotary Clubs in the sum of \$ 400.00.
